**Note:** There is not Connect for Middle School on Sunday, September 4th due to Labor Day.






## FAQ

### What is the For Generations 2.0 Campaign?

The For Generations 2.0 campaign is our stewardship campaign to raise funds to renovate existing structures and build new additions on our current campus. It will help us reach more people and minister to our current people even better. Initially, this program was scheduled to start in March of 2020, but due to COVID, was placed on hold until a later date.

### What is the plan?

The full plan includes the new construction of Elementary, Administration, Adult Education, Early Childhood spaces, and new parking for the north side of our property. For the first part of the project, we will be constructing a new Elementary building.

### How much will it cost?


The Elementary building is estimated to cost \$1.1 million. We will be paying cash for the Elementary building.

### How can I give?

By giving to For Generations 2.0, you will enable us to pay cash for the Elementary building and position us for the subsequent phases. If you're giving by check, you can give to the project by writing "For Generations" in the memo line. If you would like to make a 12-month giving commitment, you and your family will also be able to do so by filling out a commitment card.

### What about the other phases?

For Generations 2.0 also includes additional parking on the north side of the property, a new administration building, new adult education space, and additional early childhood space. All of these additions are still a part of the project and will be pursued as giving allows.
