identity. *"To those who have been called, who are loved in God the Father and kept for Jesus Christ."* Called. Loved. Kept. Three powerful reminders! You are called to make a difference, and you find yourselves in a long line of heroes like Moses, David, Elijah, Mary, and Jude! You are loved. Not just by God, but *in* God. In his family and promise of protection and inheritance. Finally you are kept. Preserved. Guarded. We certainly have a job to do—contending for the faith without compromise. Grace is not a free pass to abuse. But when we stumble and fall, we have the promise of the one who has called us in the past, the one who loves us in the present, and the one who is keeping us long into the future!
