Chains Fall Here — A new series in Romans 6–7
You weren't meant to live chained. Not to your past. Not to what's killing you. Not to what keeps dragging you back. Not to the crushing pressure of trying to be good enough.

Starting April 12, we're spending four weeks in Romans 6 and 7. Paul wrote these words to people asking the same question we ask: If Jesus has set me free, why do I still feel stuck? This isn't about behavior modification or trying harder. It's about what happens when the power of the gospel breaks what's been holding you captive. If you've been stuck, or if you've been white-knuckling your way through the Christian life, this series is for you.

Our small group does a Seder dinner every year leading up to Easter. It's such powerful and fun tradition as we look to Jesus! Part of the meal is a powerful word:



Dayenu. It means, "It would have been enough." In the traditional telling of the Exodus story, each act of God's deliverance is remembered with gratitude—if He had only done that one thing, it would have been enough. If He had only brought His people out of Egypt—Dayenu. If He had only parted the sea—Dayenu. If He had only provided in the wilderness—Dayenu. But God didn't stop there.

As we sat around the table, tasting the elements and retelling the story, we were reminded that God is not a God of "just enough." He is a God of abundance, grace, and overflow. Every step of His faithfulness builds on the last. And then we looked to Jesus. And Easter! The crucifixion AND resurrection! Forgiveness, new life, adoption into God's family, and eternal hope. Praise God that we have enough, and more than enough in Jesus!

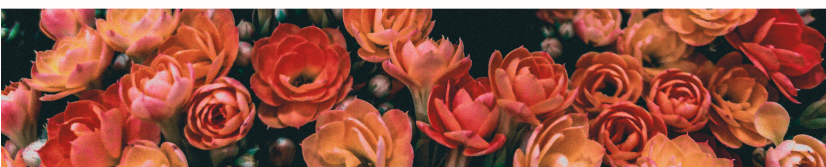

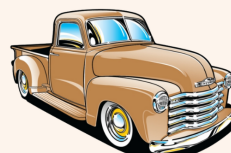

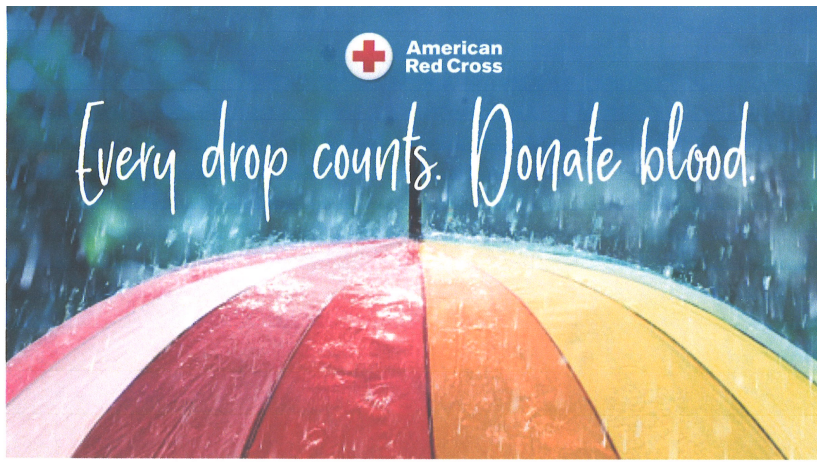
